

Hello, I am Rhe!

I'd like to guide you through the booking process and set your expectations. The trial is only for the bride, who may bring 1 – 2 guests with her. I conduct trials at my beauty studio located in West London. More details on address will be provided via email. Free parking outside.

During the trial, we will engage in a consultation to discuss your makeup preferences. This will include details such as your attire, preferred coverage (light, medium, or full), lash style, eye colours and style, brow shape, lip contour (overlined, natural, or underlined), contour intensity (light, medium, or heavy), and blush and highlight preferences.

Here's a brief overview of the process:

1. Trial (optional):

1. Book a trial in advance, post-trial you have 3 days to inform Rhe if you are going ahead whilst the date is put on provisional reservation under your name.

2. If you're sure of booking Rhe, then secure your date/ time slot before booking a trial which can be closer to Wedding date - useful if you are yet to buy wedding outfit to envision your look on the day better.

3. Proceed with no trial, trust the process!

Please note that there is a trial fee, booking of trial is agreed via communication on email.

- 2. Booking: Secure your spot with a deposit.
- 3. Confirmation: Receive confirmation details.
- 4. Follow-up: Reconfirm the address closer to the appointment date.

On the day of the appointment, ensure:

- Good Lighting: Adequate lighting for optimal results.
- Professional Setup: A small table will be arranged for my professional kit.

• Attire: If your wedding outfit goes over your head, please have it on before the appointment begins to prevent any makeup smudging caused by contact with the outfit.

Communication is key, so please express your feelings and any adjustments you desire during the session to achieve your desired end result. As part of the bridal services, you will receive a touch-up kit, including a mini lip product and a powder puff with powder.
